MEETINGS AND RESULTS	<p>Wednesday 5 May – Meeting with Guam National Olympic Committee (Bob Steffy). PURPOSE – General course discussions, express proposal to host 2011 Global Junior Circuit event, advise of schools development program. OUTCOME – All went well.</p> <p>Wednesday 5 May – GTTF Committee Meeting. PURPOSE – Discuss the future of GTTF going forward, discussion about the structure of GTTF and its clubs, discussion about hosting 2011 Global Junior Circuit Event. OUTCOMES – Clubs need to know that they have to be affiliated to GTTF to compete for Guam, events and incentives need to be created as a return for</p>																																																		

	<p>membership fees to members, supportive of hosting 2011 Global Junior Circuit event.</p> <p>Thursday 6 May – Meeting with ANZ Bank (David McCall – CEO American Territories and CEO Guam. PURPOSE – Sponsoring 2011 Global Junior Circuit Event. OUTCOME – They will be interested but they need a proposal to be put forward.</p> <p>Thursday 6 May – Meeting with Pacific Telestations Inc. (Christie San Augustin – Media Consultant and David Delgado – Sports Director). PURPOSE – TV interview for news program, also to discuss the possibility of Pacific Telestations Inc. broadcasting the proposed 2011 Guam Global Junior Circuit event. OUTCOME – Pacific Telestations Inc. to put a proposal forward including costs of production and broadcast times.</p> <p>Friday 7 May – Meeting with Perez Brothers Inc. (Tom Perez – Owning Partner). PURPOSE – Discuss 2011 Global Junior Circuit bid and sponsorship opportunities, discuss the implementation of a schools program. OUTCOME – Supportive of both ideas and will provide assistance where possible.</p> <p>Friday 7 May – Meeting with (Patrick Wolff). PURPOSE – Discuss the implementation of a schools program into middle schools on Guam. OUTCOME – Supportive of the idea, once tables have arrived things can progress further.</p>
<p>EVALUATION OF TABLE TENNIS SITUATION</p>	<p>Table tennis on Guam is definitely moving in the right direction. Being moved forward by a motivated and well resourced committee sees GTTF in a position to take table tennis to a completely new level within the next 2-3 years.</p> <p>The potential to host a Global Junior Circuit event on Guam in 2011 will provide the perfect springboard to allow Guam to be well known in the table tennis community.</p>
<p>EQUIPMENT IN COUNTRY</p>	<p>There are good equipment supplies at the moment on Guam. There are 8 high quality tables available for use at the training venue and nearly all players have access to a high quality racket.</p> <p>In addition to this, OTTF supplied 10 ITTF-PTT Level 1 Coaching Manuals, 20 rackets, 2 gross balls, and 3 nets for the visit.</p> <p>There is also a schools tables project being undertaken that will see 50 tables distributed throughout the schools on Guam with a focus on the middle schools. Once this program comes into fruition table tennis has real potential to rapidly expand in the near future.</p>

<p>FOLLOW UP REQUIRED</p>	<p>The main focus in the immediate future should be on finalizing the bid document to host a Global Junior Circuit event in 2011. If the bid is successful, a lot of careful planning between GTTF and OTTF will be required for the event to be a success.</p> <p>Coach education should also be an ongoing focus in the near future. Once the schools tables program is complete there will need to be more coaches to educate the students, so another course in 2010 would be preferable.</p>
<p>RECOMMENDATION FOR FUTURE COURSES</p>	<p>It is recommended that a Developing a National Sports Structure Course be carried out on Guam in 2011. With the vision to take table tennis to every middle school will take an extended strong effort. Having an expert on site for 2-3 months in succession would enable school teachers to become accredited as coaches and allow GTTF to expand quickly. Having an expert on site would also allow for a strong set up of the proposed Global Junior Circuit event.</p>
